Face page (PHS 398 Face Page) with official signature

• For University of Cincinnati applicants, item #12 is the name of your grants administrator in your business office and item #13 should be signed by your department head.

Abstract (PHS 398 Form Page 2, maximum 1 page)

Key Personnel (PHS 398 Form Page 2, continued)

• List PI, Mentor, Collaborators (Research assistants, student helpers, etc.). Consultants can be listed under Other Significant Contributors.

Budget and Budget Justification (PHS 398 Form Pages 4 and 5)

Provide budget justification consistent with proposed study and timeline.

Biographical Sketch (<u>form/instructions</u>)

Follow NIH format, including personal statement, for PI, Collaborators, Mentor, and Consultants. If
applying for Interdisciplinary Focus, the research team must include 2 or more areas of ERC and/or
related disciplines which should be documented in their respective bio sketches.

Project Description (PHS 398 Continuation Format Page):

Maximum 5 pages (Specific Aims through Timetable, i.e. Items #1-8)

Proposals containing Project Descriptions over 5 pages will be returned without review.

Single space, Arial font, no smaller that 11pt.

- 1. Specific Aims
- 2. Background
- 3. Burden, Need, and Impact. Each proposal must present a brief description about how their proposal addresses the Burden, Need, and Impact (BNI) aspects of the NIOSH research strategy.
- 4. Relevance to NORA Identify <u>NORA Sector</u> applicable to your proposal
- 5. Research Design and Methods
 - a. <u>Interdisciplinary Focus Option, ERC Strategic Priorities Focus Option, or Underserved/Underrepresented Option</u>. If applying for this optional additional funding, provide rationale and names of the research team with their expertise **in a clearly labeled sub-section** in the Research Design and Methods section (bio sketches should be included in previous section).
- 6. Expected results
- 7. Impact statement of your research to occupational safety and health
- 8. Future direction
- 9. Timetable
- 10. Bibliography/References Cited (additional 2 pages are allowed)
- 11. Human Subjects Research Description*
 - a. If research involves human subjects, the following must be included in this section: Subject Source, Recruitment Plan, Protection of Human Subjects, Inclusion of Women and Minorities, Planned Enrollment Report, Inclusion of Children
- 12. Vertebrate Animals Research Description* (if applicable)
