

## **Current Barriers**

- Immigrants in Cincinnati face major linguistic and cultural barriers when seeking healthcare.
- Community Health Workers (CHW) programs exist only in a few hospitals
- Inequitable access to social services, health education, and care navigation.



## **Proposal**

- 1. Fund a citywide or hospital-based CHW program.
- 2. Recruit bilingual community members.
- 3. Train CHWs with a standardized curriculum (e.g., Cincinnati State model).
- 4. Incentivize hospitals to integrate CHWs into care teams.
