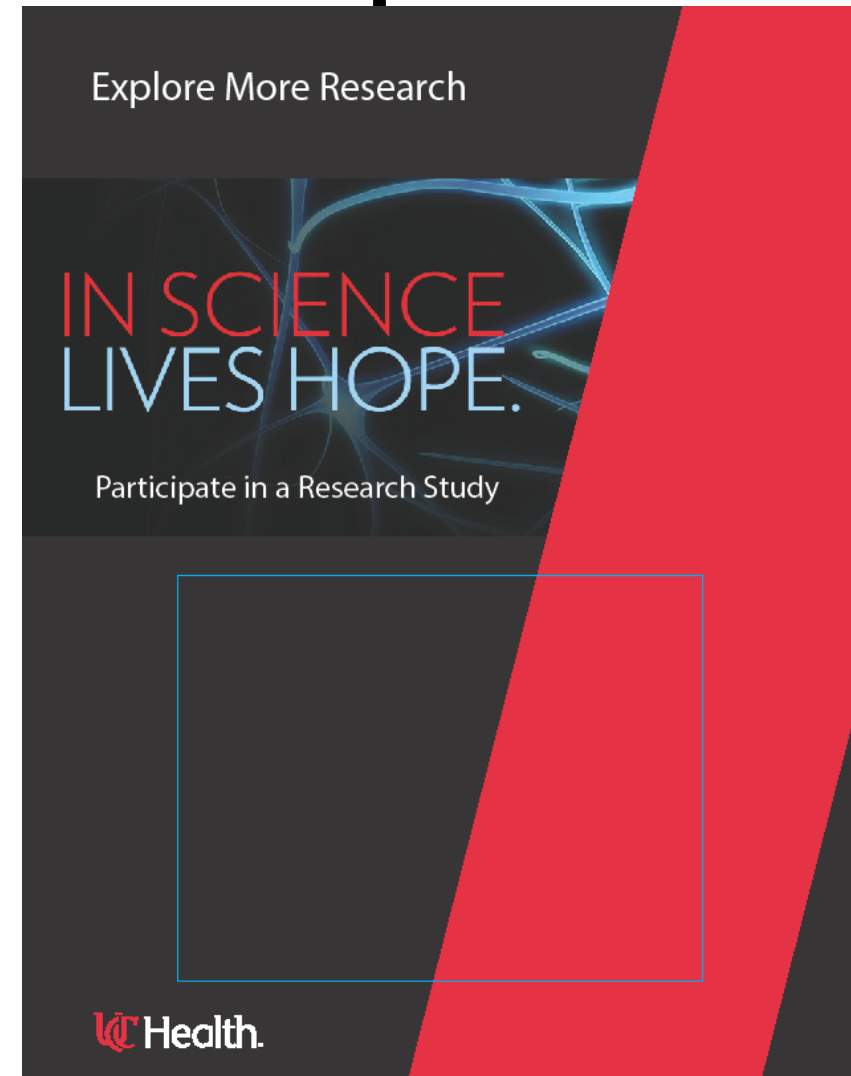
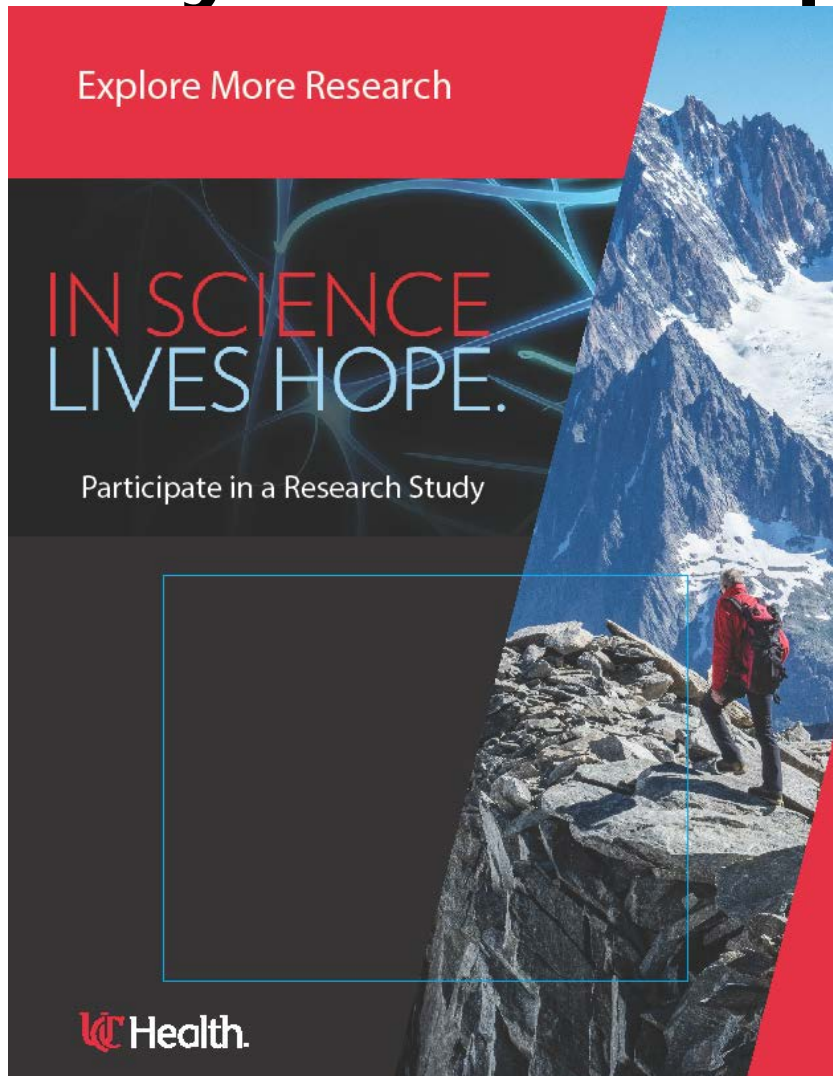

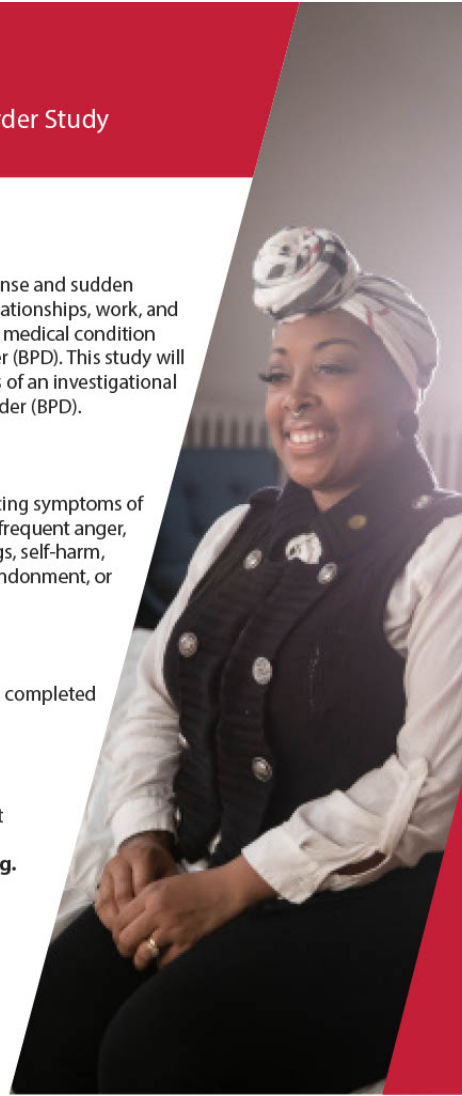

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. How many blood draws will there be?
  - There will be between 2-5 blood draws a year with your child.
2. Does my child have to get an influenza vaccination to be in this study?
  - No. You can participate whether or not you decide to have your child vaccinated for flu.
3. Where will I need to come for study visits?
  - Your enrollment visit will occur at your prenatal care clinic or Cincinnati Children's Hospital. Subsequent study visits will occur at Cincinnati Children's Schubert Research Center. There will be a home visit at 2 weeks of age, and there may be additional home visits each year if your child becomes infected with the flu.
4. What are the risks of participating in this study?
  - The only discomforts you and your child may experience are from blood draws and nasal swab collections.
5. What are the benefits of participating?
  - Positive flu test results will be made available to you and your child's doctor and can be used to guide medical care decisions. This study will increase knowledge of flu illness in children and possibly help prevent illness in the future.

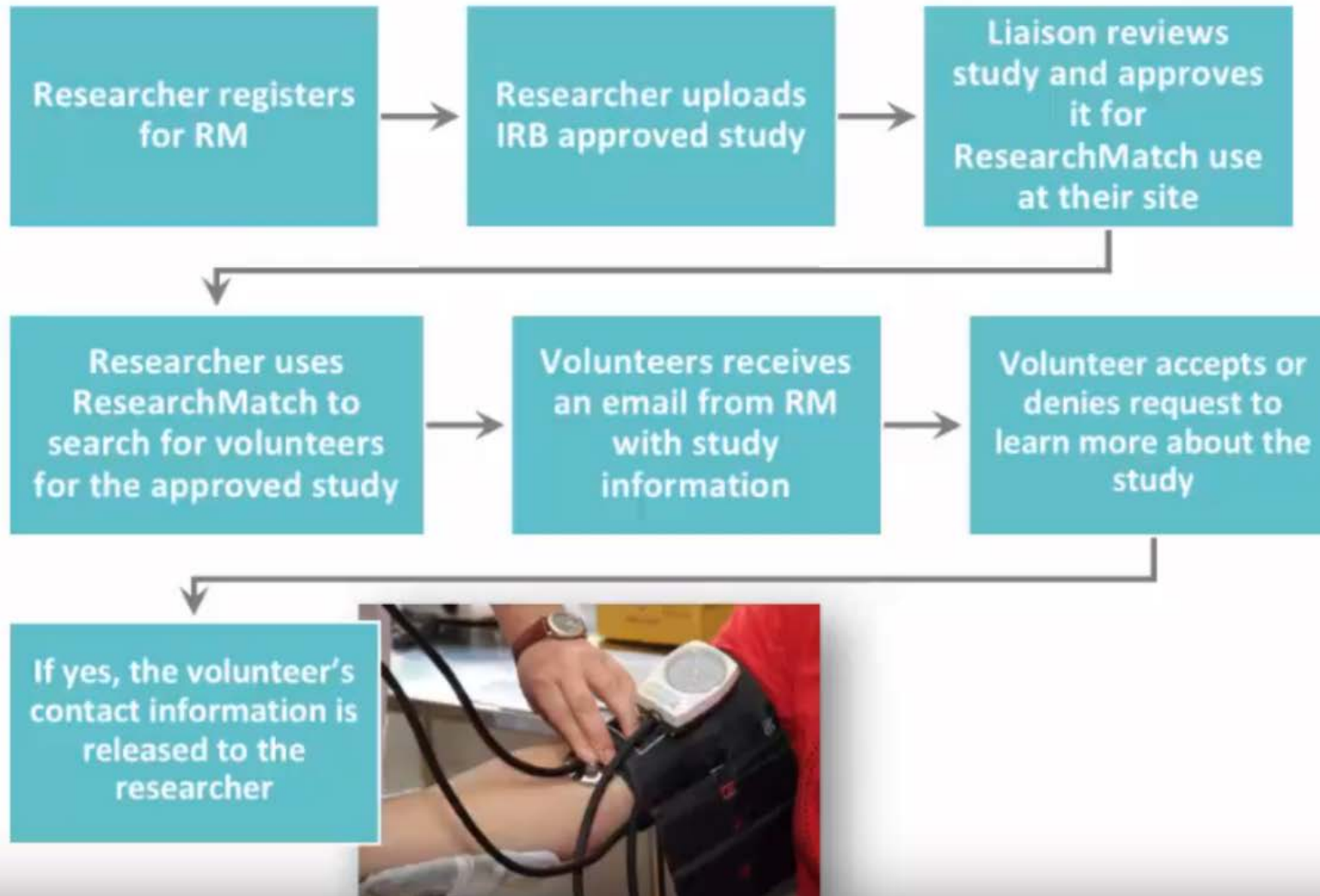

# ResearchMatch Overview

- Hosted by Vanderbilt University Medical Center
- Funded by the National Institutes of Health
- Free online recruitment platform
- Matches potential participants with Clinical Research Studies throughout the United States

- **Researcher:** person who has been given access to use ResearchMatch.org for recruitment.
- **Institutional Liaison:** person at your institution who reviews your access into the ResearchMatch system
- **Feasibility Access:** An access level that allows researchers to conduct searches on ResearchMatch for informational purposes only. The researcher does not need an IRB approved study.
- **Recruitment Access:** An access level that allows researchers to use ResearchMatch for contacting potential volunteers. The researcher must have an IRB approved study and an IRB approved contact message.
- **Contact Message:** The information a researcher sends through the ResearchMatch system to potential volunteers.

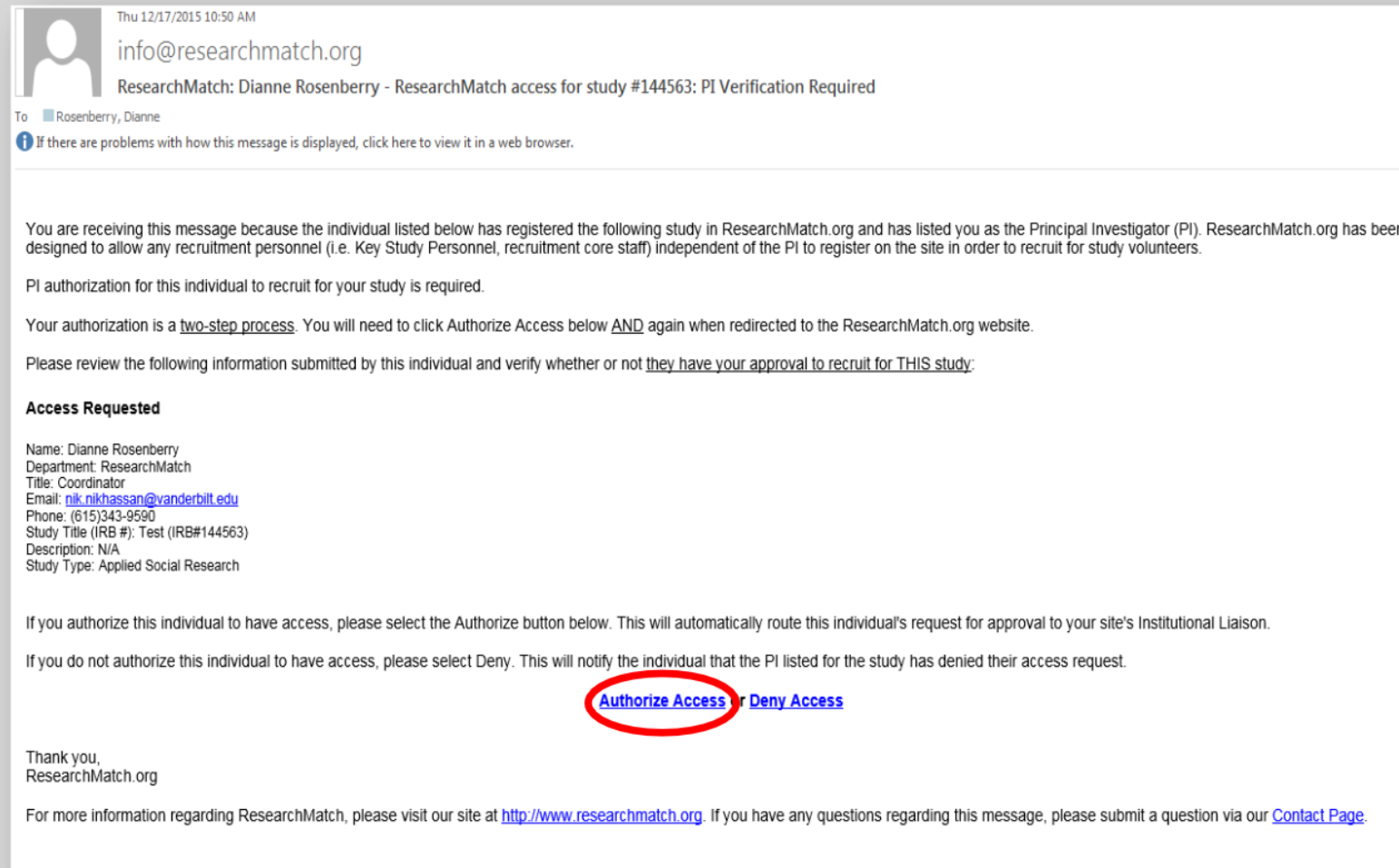
