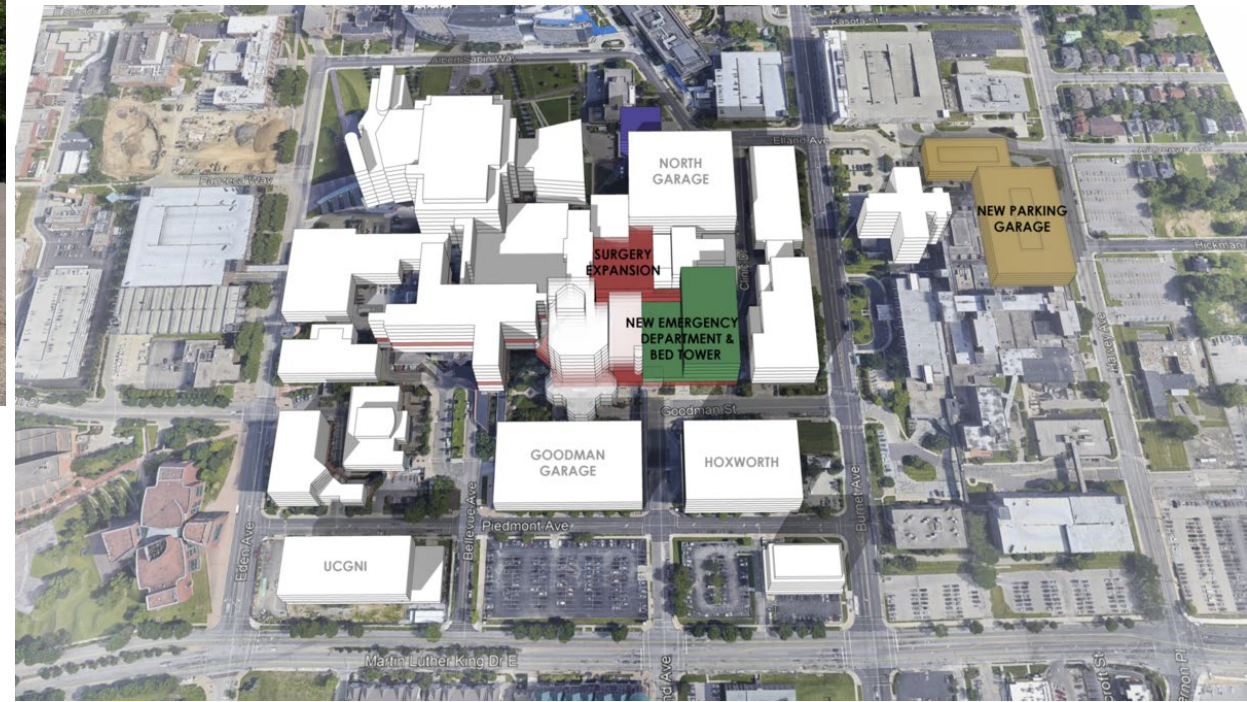

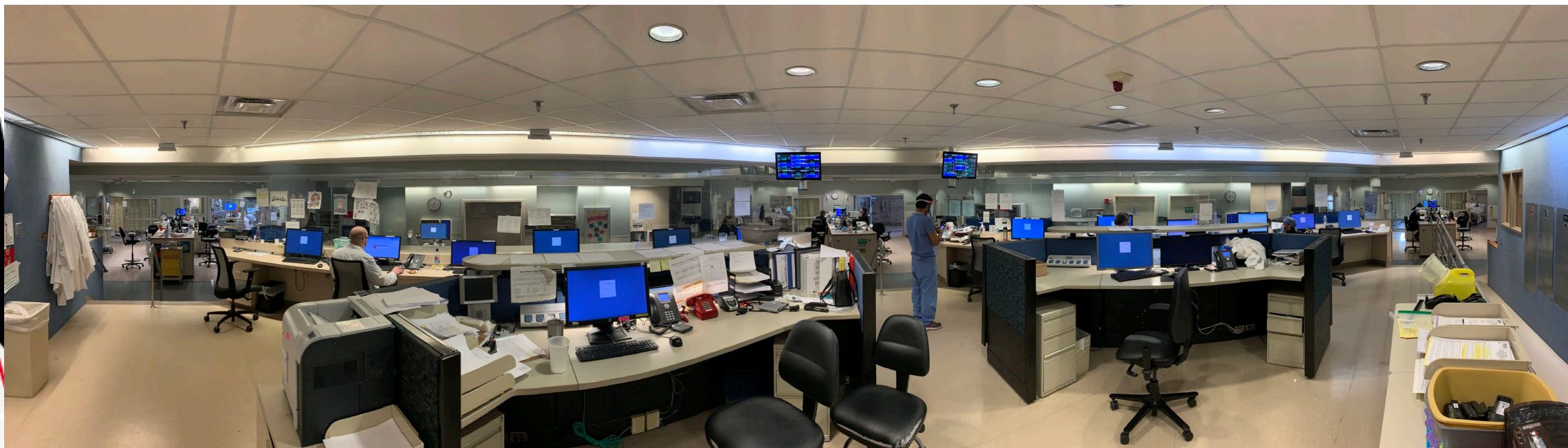
How are we different?
