- 1-page synopsis of your academic history and leadership/extracurriculars (like a resume)
- 1-page personal statement addressing:
  - 1. why you feel this program will benefit you and
  - any background/prior related experience that would make you a good fit for this program.

Previous research experience is not a requirement.

The application will also require;

- Your current high school GPA
- · Date of birth
- Name of high school
- Class graduation year (i.e. 2026 for current juniors and 2027 for current sophomores). All applicants must be 16 years old at the time of the session.
- Selection of preferred track and session.
